

## **Full Demo Install Instructions**

### ***Introduction***

- Each **full demo** download installs a runtime version of Microsoft Access 2003 which you are licensed to use as per the end users license agreement.
- The Access Runtime version has certain features disabled, including the ability to create and modify databases.
- If you have Microsoft Access 2003, 2007, or 2010 already installed,
  - DO NOT INSTALL THE RUNTIME VERSION.
  - simply download and run the *database only* (see downloads section on the website).

### ***Installing the Demonstration Software***

- Download the install package (*filename.zip*), save the file locally and remember the file location.
- **Unzip or extract the file.**
  - **Do not launch Setup.exe from within the unzip utility.** You may experience problems uninstalling the software if launched from the zip file.
  - **Unzip or extract the file before launching setup.exe.**
- Double click on Setup.exe to launch the setup wizard.
  - Or, select the start menu, select run, select browse. Then locate Setup.exe from your file location. Select OK.
- The setup wizard will begin and install the software and a runtime version of Microsoft Access.
- Select TYPICAL (not CUSTOM) from the setup options and continue.

### ***Demo products***

- Each database is a demo product which allows the user to install and run the products 25 times.
- After the 25<sup>th</sup> time, the product must be purchased and a valid registration product Key will be provided. Once entered, this product key will allow unlimited use of the software.
- In this way, a user may enter actual data in the demo version which will not be lost when the product is registered.

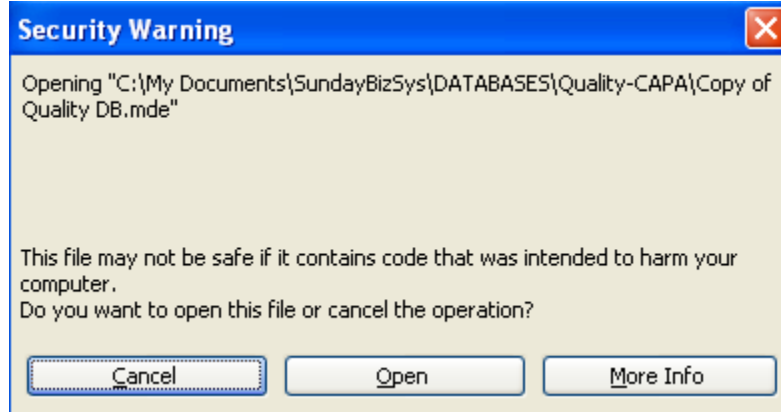
### ***Other SBS products***

- SBS offers other products as trial downloads.
- These products may be included in a folder named “More Tools” or downloaded directly from the website. No further installation is required to run these tools. Simply copy the file to the desired location on your hard drive and launch a file normally.
- Once a full demo is installed (with the Access runtime version), other databases may be downloaded and unzipped. There is no need to install the full demo version with the runtime install included. Refer to further instructions on [www.SundayBizSys.com](http://www.SundayBizSys.com).

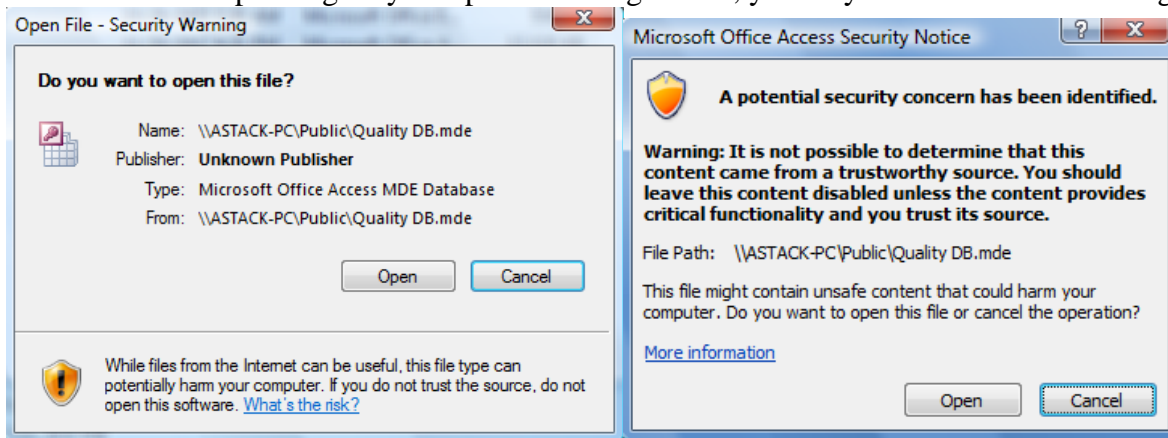

## Microsoft Security Considerations

- Microsoft Access 2003
  - Access 2003 posts several security prompts when the database is launched:

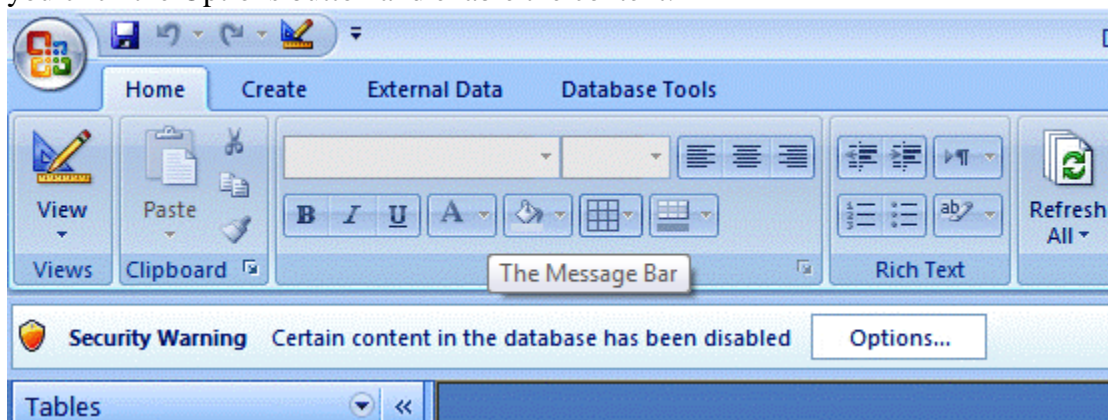


- SBS databases do not contain code intended to harm your computer. Every precaution is taken to ensure a safe product. The databases have been scanned for viruses using up to date virus detection.
  - Select Open to continue
- Microsoft Access 2007 in Windows Vista
  - Depending on your specific configuration, you may encounter the following screens:



- In each case, SBS products are not malicious or intended to harm your computer. Click on the open button.

- If you get the following security warning, the database will be functionally disabled until you click the Options button and enable the content:



- Sunday Business Systems recommends saving the Database in a Trusted Location using Trusted Center in Access 2007.
  - To open the **Trust Center**, click the **Microsoft Office Button** in the upper-left corner of the Access window, and then click **Access Options**. Click **Trust Center** in the left pane, and then select **Trust Center Settings**.

## What to Download

- Use the following table as a guide to select the proper download:

Software installed on your computer	Download	Comments
Microsoft Access is not installed	the <i>Full Demo</i>	This installs a free runtime version of Access 2003 in addition to the SBS database
Microsoft Access 97, Microsoft Access 2000, or Microsoft Access 2002	the <i>Full Demo</i>	This installs a free runtime version of Access 2003 in addition to the SBS database
Microsoft Access 2003	the <i>Database Only</i>	A .mde file will be saved locally
Microsoft Access 2007	the <i>Database Only</i>	Do not download and install the Full Demo (which will try to install a runtime version of Access 2003)
